BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Remove all packaging materials from in and around the blender and verify that all parts are accounted for.
- Place the blender on a stable, level surface, away from external heat sources.
- Read all Important safeguards and cautionary information in this user guide. Failure to do so may result in property damage and/or personal injury.
- Follow care & maintenance instructions in this user guide to clean the blender.
- Do not remove safety warning stickers or rating label.

GENERAL SAFETY REGULATIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed including the followings.


READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING & SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plug, or main body (motor) in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet before assembling, before taking off parts, before cleaning and when not in
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Always securely clamp in place all parts before the motor is turned on. Do not unfasten while appliance is in operation.
- Avoid contacting moving parts. Make sure that the motor stops completely before disassembling.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Do not walk away from the appliance when it is in operation
- Do not disassemble the Base.
- Do not put any foreign materials into the machine.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter or touch heated surfaces.
- To disconnect, press/switch OFF then remove plug from wall outlet. Make sure the motor stops completely before disassembling.
- Do not operate the blender for more than 60 seconds at a time. Always make sure wait a minute before operating again



- Operator must obey a rated intermittent time; it is forbidden to make it idle run or overload Changing the power cord shall be operated by the professional maintenance personnel.
- The blade base should be firmly locked with the jar, or there is a risk of water leakage and jar falling.
- The blade is very sharp, pay attention not to hurt your hand when cleaning and disassembling the machine.
- Continuous working time for each operation cannot exceed 60 seconds. It can only be used after the unit is completely cooled.
- The motor of this machine has an over-temperature protection device, the machine will be paused because of overheating during operating, at this moment, you should cut off the power supply, restart it till it is completely cooled.
- The processing material in the blending cup should not exceed the maximum scale-line position of the cup.
- Do not directly use water to wash the main engine, and it will cause electrical failure or accident of motor and switch.

USING YOUR SOLARA BLENDEASY BLENDER

Blend/Chop/Grate/Crush

- Place the machine on a stable table.
- Screw on the cross-blade base to the bottom of the blender jar or the smart jar.
- Add your ingredients, making sure there is enough liquid.
- Make sure the whole mixed volume does not exceed the maximum scale-line position of the jar.
- Place the lid, then tighten it clockwise.
- Plug in the unit into 220-240 voltage.
- Put the blending jar on the motor unit making sure it fits properly and simply twist clockwise.
- Make sure to operate only in intervals less than 60 seconds each.

Grind/Whip

- Place the food in the small jar, making sure it does not exceed 100g.
- Twist the flat blade on the bottom of small jar and fix it on the main motor unit.
- Plug in the machine.
- Usually, 30 seconds should be enough to do the grind.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Make sure to turn off the unit before cleaning activities.
- Always wash your blender attachments immediately after use.
- Never immerse the main motor unit in water.
- Do not spray water on the main motor unit.
- Only wipe clean the main motor unit.
- Store in a dry, well-ventilated area.
